GOVERNANCE CISCBC - 209

Rationale

Catholic schools in BC have been in existence since the late 1800's. Today, the five (5) Catholic dioceses in the province support Catholic schools which provide religious and moral reference points to help students critically examine the culture around them and build a society enlightened by the values of the Gospel.

The Catholic Independent School Committee of British Columbia (CISCBC) is the provincial organization for Catholic schools in British Columbia and represents issues and concerns on behalf of Catholic schools to the Federation of the Independent Schools Association (FISA) of British Columbia. Three members from this committee are voted in annually as the FISA BC representatives for CISBC.

Policy

The CISKD Board of Directors recognizes the Catholic Independent School Committee of British Columbia (CISCBC) as the provincial organization for Catholic schools in British Columbia.

Regulation

At its first meeting of the school year the Board of Directors will appoint one member to represent the CISKD on the Catholic Independent School Committee of British Columbia; and an alternate to serve if the appointed person is unable to attend.
