BUSINESS PROCEDURES
TUITION FEES – 703

Rationale

Many people including parents and teachers make financial sacrifices in order to provide quality Catholic education in the Kamloops Diocese.

Catholic schools in British Columbia receive 50% of the operating costs allocated to public schools. No government funding is received for capital expenditures. The annual school budget is determined by and takes into account the required tuition from each family.

Policy

The Board of Directors believes that the establishment and collection of tuition fees should be done in a fair and equitable manner.

Procedure

- 1. The Principal, in consultation with the Local School Committee, will establish a local tuition policy for their school.
- 2. The Local School Committee will on an annual basis:
 - a) Establish tuition fees,
 - b) Set student fees, and/or other fees as may be required,
 - c) Administer the collection and disbursement of these fees.
- 3. The Parish Finance Committee will endeavor to assist parents who cannot meet their financial obligations. Parents are asked to contact their local Parish Priest for details.
- 4. The Local School Committee may establish Parish Supporter and Non-Supporter tuition fees.
